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#### 1. Introduction:

The Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon was established on 15<sup>th</sup> August 1990 under the Maharashtra University Act (No. XXIX) of 1989, to establish and promote facilities for advanced and applied education in the North Maharashtra region. In higher education, the Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University has achieved a distinctive place for more than 30 years. The university is re-accredited and awarded an 'A' grade (4<sup>th</sup> Cycle) by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore in 2022.

The University offers various innovative academic programs in the faculties of Science and Technology, Commerce and Management, Humanities, and Inter-Disciplinary Studies ensuring bright career prospects and opportunities in the academics and industries. It is a matter of pride that 13 Schools on the University campus have established themselves as centers of academic excellence over the years, which offer various Graduate, Postgraduate, M.Phil., and Doctoral (Ph.D.) programs. The schools are well-equipped with modern laboratories. Most of the courses are industry oriented and students are getting jobs in appropriate fields.

The University campus is spread over 660 acres of land on hilly terrain, 11 km away from the city of Jalgaon and the western bank of the river Girna. Three districts viz. Jalgaon, Dhule, and Nandurbar fall under the jurisdiction of the University. The region has its own rich cultural and tribal heritage. While developing the site, the University has taken utmost care to preserve the natural fabric of hilly terrain. Beautifully designed spacious buildings have been constructed to serve academic, administrative, and residential purposes. More than two lakh trees have been planted to conserve the natural beauty and environment of the campus, for which the university was selected for the "Vanashree Award - 2000" by Government of Maharashtra and "Indira Priyadarshini Vriksha Mitra (IPVM) Award- 2002" by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

University also facilitates various Govt. scholarships and fellowships to meritorious, eligible, and financially deprived students such as the Eklavya Vidhyadhan Loan Scheme, Financial Assistance to Economically Backward Students, Scholarship / Free ship to SC, OBC, NT, SBC students from Govt. of Maharashtra, Scholarship / Free ship to ST students sponsored by Ekatmik Aadivasi Vikas Vibhag, Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn-and-Learn Scheme, Student Research Scheme, Vice Chancellor Medical Help Scheme, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Hostel Student Financial Scheme, KBCNMU Student Adoption Scheme, etc. The detailed eligibility criteria for the schemes can be obtained from the University/School website.

Furthermore, various Workshops and Student Development Programs such as Cultural Workshops, Bravery Workshop, Yuvati Sabha, Yuvarang, Open House, Aavishkar, etc. are also periodically organized to cater to the overall development of students.

The university also has a dedicated Central Training and Placement Cell that caters for the campus placement opportunities to in-campus and affiliated Institutes and Colleges. Additionally, an IGNOU study center is also located on the University campus that provides students an opportunity to pursue various certificate, diploma, bachelor, and post-graduate distance learning courses in addition to regular enrolled courses simultaneously (for details visit <a href="http://www.ignou.ac.in">http://www.ignou.ac.in</a>).

#### 2. RUSA Resource Centre for Inclusive Education:

Coinciding the Govt. of India initiatives, the University has recently established the RUSA Resource Center for Inclusive Education in the spacious building of the Knowledge Resource Center (formerly Central Library) that works as a catalyst between the 'Specially/Differently Abled Persons' (विव्यांग) and the modern world. Presently, the Assistive Technology Laboratory has a state-of-the-art computational facility and periodically organizes various hands-on, technical, and awareness/sensitization workshops providing new avenues of education and knowledge of auxiliary information resources for 'Specially/Differently Abled Persons' (विव्यांग) free of cost. Presently, the Government of India (GOI) has prescribed the following list of twenty-one types of disabilities for 'Specially/Differently Abled Persons' (विव्यांग).

#### 3. Definitions:

- (a) "Application Form" means the prescribed form filled up online by the candidate for admission.
- (b) "CAP Seats" means the seats filled in through the centralized admission process (CAP) carried out by the university.
- (c) "Courses" means the M.Sc./M.A. courses.
- (d) "Eligible Candidates" means the candidates who are eligible for different courses as notified by the University/Government.
- (e) "Application Receipt Center (ARC)" means a Centre where facilities like verification of documents and grievances, etc., are provided.
- (f) "Home University (HU)" means the Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University.
- (g) "OHU" means the area Outside the Home University area.
- (h) "Institutional (Management) Quota" means seats available for admission to eligible candidates at the institution level as declared by the university from time to time.
- (i) "Qualifying Examination" means examinations based on which a candidate becomes eligible for admission or its equivalent examination.
- (j) "HSC" means the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Standard XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent certificate awarded by a recognized board.
- (k) "SSC" means the Secondary School Certificate (Standard X) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent certificate awarded by a recognized board.

### 4. Implementation of National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020):

The Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University implemented the National Education Policy 2020 with effect from the academic year 2023-24 for Post Graduate courses. The curricula and structure of MSc/MA courses have been changed in line with the structure and features of NEP-2020.

(i) Restructured syllabi: The newly designed curricula are available on the University website. The main features of the new structure of postgraduate courses are the division of core subjects into Discipline Specific Core Subjects (DSC) and Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSE).

- (ii) Emphasis on job-oriented training: The new structure offers Job Training (Internship/Apprenticeship), courses on Research Methodology, and Research Projects.
- (iii) Dual Language Program: At the University campus from the academic year 2023-24 students can select the 'Dual Language Program' option of learning. These Dual Language programs are available for three Programs (M.Sc. in Computer Science, M.Sc. in Mathematics, and M.A./M.Sc. in Applied Geography). The course material, teaching, and examination will be available in 'Marathi' along with 'English' language. There is no separate additional intake for these dual language programs.

#### 5. Sanctioned intake for various courses:

The sanctioned intake for first-year M.Sc. courses shall be as per the affiliation and approval given by the University.

#### 6. Allocation of seats:

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates in the Home University (HU), Other University (OU), Institutional (Management) Quota, and Industry Sponsored Seats is as follows:

#### 6.1 Allocation of seats at University Schools

Candidates graduated from KBC North Maharashtra University: 90%

Candidates graduated from Other Universities: 10%

Industry-sponsored seats: In addition to existing seats for all courses five (5) extra seats are allotted for industrial-sponsored candidates (two (2) extra seats for M.Sc. Chemistry).

#### **6.2** Allocation of seats at affiliated Colleges

(a) Granted courses

Candidates graduated from KBC North Maharashtra University: 90%

Candidates graduated from other universities: 10%

(b) Non-granted courses

Candidates graduated from KBC North Maharashtra University: 70%

Candidates graduated from other universities: 10%

Seats to be allotted through management quota: 20%

Industry-sponsored seats: one (1) seat for the first ten (10) intake capacities subject to a maximum of two per course.

#### **6.3** Admission process for industry-sponsored candidates:

- 1) For an application under an industry-sponsored quota, it is mandatory to fill out the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) application form.
- 2) After the CAP rounds, candidates with industry sponsorship may apply to the respective University School or the affiliated College under the industry-sponsored quota with a letter of sponsorship from industry.
- 3) Admission under an industry-sponsored quota will be done purely based on a merit list prepared separately by the respective institute.

#### 7. Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall apply to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) Reservation for various class/category candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward and other class/categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservations is the

percentage of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, coming under the CAP. Backward and other class/category candidates shall claim the category to which they belong at the time of submission of the application form for CAP.

#### (b) Reservation for wards of defense service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats out of the total sanctioned intake capacity of University Schools and affiliated Colleges as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (1) seat in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for wards of exservice personnel who are from Maharashtra state.

#### (c) Reservation for persons with disability candidates:

Five percent (5%) seats of the total sanctioned intake capacity of University Schools and affiliated Colleges as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (1) seat in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for candidates with a disability.

The allotment of seats reserved for candidates with disability shall be done based on merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the Physical Disability Certificates. **Note:** Candidates with a disability should note that on admission to a degree course, they will not be given any exemptions or additional facilities in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the University.

#### (d) Reservation for persons suffering from Cancer:

A maximum of one seat per course per institute can be allotted to candidates suffering from cancer. The allotment of seats for the candidates suffering from cancer shall be done based on merit. The candidates claiming admission under this category shall submit the necessary certificate duly signed by a Civil Surgeon.

- (e) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of the total intake capacity of university schools and affiliated Colleges as a whole separately will be offered to the SBC category.
- (f) Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate: As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. रাসাधो-4019/Ĥ.Đ.31/16-अ, dated 12<sup>th</sup> February 2019, 10% of seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates.
- (g) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission for various postgraduate courses, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be a separate merit list for other University students.
- (h) Any change from the Maharashtra Government in terms of reservation before the commencement of CAP Admission Rounds will be taken into consideration.
- (i) Candidates once admitted through industry-sponsored quota will not be allowed to shift to the general quota under any circumstances.

#### 8. Eligibility criteria:

#### • General criteria:

A candidate is eligible for admission to the postgraduate courses offered by various Schools/affiliated Colleges of the University if he/she has secured at least 50% (or equivalent CGPA) marks at graduation (45% marks for backward class i.e. SC/ST/DT/NT/OBC/SBC/SEBC category candidates from Maharashtra state).

The specific eligibility criteria in addition to the above general for admission to various post-graduate courses are as follows:

#### 9. Preparation of merit list:

- **9.1 Assignment of merit number:** All eligible candidates who have submitted the online application form on or before the last date specified for the online submission and verified and confirmed their application form at the Application Receipt Center (ARC) shall be assigned a merit number. The merit list shall be prepared based on the score obtained at the qualifying examination and the specific eligibility mentioned above.
- 9.2 Change of marks due to verification: If the marks in the qualifying examination are modified due to verification/redressal and the same is duly certified by the concerned competent authority, the same shall be reported to the following ARC: School of Computer Sciences, KBCNMU, Jalgaon for admission through CAP immediately. However, the effect of such change will be taken into consideration only for the subsequent round(s) of admission.

#### 9.3 Method of calculating marks at qualifying examination for deciding eligibility:

(a) The group-wise or subject-wise separate general merit list for the Home University and other Universities for eligible candidates will be generated based on their performance at graduation as per eligibility criteria.

- (b) The marks/CGPA obtained by the candidate in the principal subject in the second and third year of graduation will be considered while preparing the merit list. The marks/CGPA will be converted to a '10 point' CGPA scale.
- (c) The tie cases of the candidates will be resolved as:
  - (i) based on total marks/CGPA of the second year at the graduate level,
  - (ii) based on first-year marks/CGPA,
  - (iii) based on marks obtained at H.S.C.
  - (iv) based on the date of birth of the candidate.

### 10. Online Centralized Admission Process (CAP):

#### 10.1 The stages of Online CAP shall be as stated below:

- (a) Display or publish of information brochure: The information brochure shall be published on the website of the University.
- (b) Group-wise online application: The candidate is required to apply online for the below-mentioned groups. Applying for one group covers all courses underlined in that group. Candidates eligible for more than one group need to apply separately for different groups.

#### Important Steps in Online Centralized Admission Process (CAP)

- 1. Online Application through the University Website.
- 2. Online Payment of Application Fee (Rs. 500) per application.
- 3. Document Verification and Confirmation of Application Form at any of the ARCs.
- 4. Display of General Merit List on the University Website.
- 5. Online round of admissions as per the schedule given with the merit list.

#### 11. Online application process:

- (a) Filling online application form by the candidate for participation in the Online Centralized Admission Process:
  - i) All aspiring candidates shall fill in the online application form for M.A/M.Sc. admission is available on the University's website.
  - ii) The candidate should read the information brochure carefully.
  - iii) The candidate should fill in the online application form as per the notified schedule for respective admission.
  - iv) Application fee for the M.A./M.Sc. Centralized Admission Process is Rs. 500/- payable through online mode and is the same for all students.
  - v) The candidates will be able to fill in the online application form through any computer connected to the internet from home/cybercafé.
  - vi) Candidates are required to fill in all the details as per the instructions. Please note the user ID and form number for future reference.
  - vii) After filling in the information and submission of the application form, he/she shall verify the data filled in and correct it if required.

- viii) The application form and documents uploaded will be **physically verified** at any of the Application Receipt Centers (ARC). **The candidate is required to report to any one of the Application Receipt Centers (ARC) in person for document verification.**
- ix) Candidate can edit/update the information in his application form before his/her application form is confirmed by the Application Receipt Center (ARC).

# (b) Confirmation of online application form and document verification at the Application Receipt Centre (ARC):

- i) The candidate shall visit any one of the Application Receipt Centers (ARC) for verification of documents.
- ii) The Application Receipt Center (ARC) In-charge shall verify the information given in an online application form with the original documents presented by the candidate. Original documents will not be retained by ARC.
- iii) The Application Receipt Center (ARC) In-charge shall confirm the candidate's application form through an online system and issue the Receipt cum Acknowledgement slip of the application form to the candidate.
- iv) After confirmation of the application form information cannot be changed by the candidate.
- v) All the candidates belonging to Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University must do document verification in person at the Application Receipt Center (ARC), failing to do so he/she will not be eligible for CAP rounds for admission.
- vi) The Other University candidate's document verification will be done by the School of Computer Sciences (ARC) in person/ through online mode. Other University candidates need not visit ARC for document verification. However, their online submitted documents will be verified at the time of CAP rounds.

# (c) Display of provisional general merit list, submission of grievances, if any, and display of final merit list on the university website:

- i) A provisional general merit list of eligible candidates will be displayed on the University website. The subject-wise general merit list will not be published in the newspaper, nor will it be communicated personally to the candidates.
- ii) For discrepancy if any, in the provisional merit list candidates can submit the grievances in writing along with the required document at the Application

Receipt Centre (ARC) where the candidate has confirmed the application form within the specified grievance period given in the schedule.

- iii) No document shall be accepted to substantiate the claim made in the application after the scheduled dates.
- iv) The final general merit list will be displayed on the University website.

**Note:** The general merit list gives the relative position of the candidate, and it does not guarantee admission to any of the courses.

#### 12. CAP rounds:

(a) Display of available category-wise seats (seat matrix) for CAP round(s):

The university shall publish the information about institutes, courses offered, sanctioned intake, and number of seats available for each category before the commencement of each CAP round(s) in the form of Seat Matrix.

#### (b) Filling up and confirmation of online option form:

Filling up and confirmation of online option form having preferences of courses and institutions before CAP round I/II. Candidates may fill a minimum of one and a maximum of thirty choices of institutes and courses in decreasing order of their preference. The option form once confirmed by the candidate through their login shall be considered for allotment for that CAP round and cannot be changed for that CAP round. The candidate should fill in a fresh option form for each CAP round(s).

- (c) Display of provisional allotment of CAP Round indicating allotted institute and Course.
- (d) 'FREEZE', or 'FLOAT' the choice of academic program:

During the CAP rounds(s), before accepting the allotted seat a candidate can opt to 'FREEZE, or 'FLOAT' the choice of the academic program for the subsequent round(s), of seat allocation, as provided below:

- (i) Freeze: Candidates accept the offered seat and they do not want to participate in any further rounds of seat allocation. Such Candidates will not be considered in subsequent rounds of admission.

Else, they will continue with the currently accepted academic program. Such candidates will be considered in the subsequent round (Round II) of admission.

- (iii) For Candidates who choose the 'Float' option and secure a seat of their choice of higher preference, then it would automatically result in the forfeiture of the seat accepted by the candidate in the earlier round.

#### (e) Confirmation of admission:

Reporting and accepting the offered seat (confirmation of admission) as per the allotment of the CAP Round I/II by the candidate.

### 13. Admissions in institutional (management) quota:

The Director/Principal of the affiliated College shall carry out the admissions for these seats in the following manner.

- (a) Admissions shall be made in a transparent manner and strictly as per the merit of the candidates who have applied for CAP.
- (b) Application for institutional (management) quota should begin after completion of CAP rounds.
- (c) Aspiring candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria as notified by the University, from time to time, shall apply to the Principal or Director of the respective institution for admission at the Institution level.
- (d) The institution may give admission to the applicants based on their merit derived from the merit list declared by the University.
- (e) The institution shall prepare and display the merit list of the candidates to be filled in at the institution level, in the institutional quota, on the notice board, and shall publish the same on the website of the institution.

(f) The institution intending to surrender the institutional quota (in part or full) of specified courses to the CAP shall communicate five days before the display of the seat matrix of CAP Round - I and the same shall be allotted as per the rules of CAP.

#### 14. Institution level round:

If the seats remain vacant after all CAP rounds, the said seats shall be filled in by the institution through the institution-level round with the prior approval of the University.

#### 15. Refund of fee after cancellation of admission:

- (a) The candidate shall apply for cancellation and submit a signed copy of the application for cancellation of admission to the institution.
- (b) After receiving an admission cancellation request from the candidate, the institution shall cancel the admission immediately online generate an online acknowledgment of cancellation of admission through institution login, and issue a signed copy to the candidate.
- (c) No candidate will be allowed to cancel his/her admission without paying the complete fees of the course for which he/she got admitted.
- (d) The candidate canceling his/her admission within seven days from the date of his/her admission, a deduction to the tune of 10% of the total amount of the tuition fee plus Rs. 500/- will be made towards administrative processing charges.
- (e) The candidate canceling his/her admission within 30 days from the date of his/her admission, a deduction to the tune of 25% of the total amount of the tuition fee plus Rs. 500/- will be made towards administrative processing charges.
- (f) The candidate canceling his/her admission after 30 days from the date of his/her admission, a refund towards any kind of fees will not be made.
- (g) No refund will be made to any candidate admitted through industry-sponsored quota.

- (i) Failure of the candidate to make full and correct statements in the application form and/or suppression of any information and/or submission of false documents shall lead to disqualification of the candidate from the examination or at a later stage during the admission process such candidate will be debarred from the entire selection process.
- (ii) Any issue not dealt with here-in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the university.

#### 19. Hostel accommodation:

#### a) University Schools

At present, the University campus has limited accommodation in hostels available for both girls and boys. Hostel admissions for Boys/Girls will be made on a merit basis. Students should arrange internal transportation facilities themselves. The admitted candidate should follow the admission schedule for hostel admission.
