Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of this University by the University Grants Commission vide its D.O.Letter No.F.137-1/92(IC-1) dtd. 28th September 1992 that the SAARC countries have instituted a few Fellowships/Scholarships in various disciplines. I am enclosing herewith application form alongwith details and terms and conditions of the same. You are requested to kindly circulate this amongst all the students. I request you to kindly forward the application of only those interested, qualified scholars which in your opinion would complete their plans satisfactorily and also project a good image of our country. While doing so, preference may be given to deserving women candidates.

The commission will forward the nominations of selected scholars to the Ministry of External Affairs, SAARC Secretariat. The final selection and placement will be made by the concerned countries. The scholars finally selected for the awards of Fellowship by the SAARC country will be entitled to get (not for Medical Engg. & Agriculture Institution) full pay and admission allowances as per university rules for the period of fellowship. The commission will reimburse this expenditure on receipt of the claim from concerned university/college/institution. In case any substitute is appointed in his/her place, the university/college/institute will have to meet the expenditure itself. In case of Fellowship the international travel fare by excursion/economy class and local travel in India by Train/Bus will be provided by the University Grants Commission to the selected scholars. This expenditure will be paid to the college/institution forwarding the application of the scholar on reimbursement basis.


In case of scholarship air-ticket may be arranged by the University Grants Commission.

You are therefore, required to forward the applications, in triplicate, from such interested and qualified scholars, direct to the University Grants Commission, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi earliest by 20th October 1992, under advice to the university. Please

note that incomplete nominations will not be entertained by the commission. The candidates called for interview will come at their own expenses.

Terms of Fellowships/Scholarships

FELLOWSHIP

- Bangladesh
- Maintenance Allowance : TK 5,000/- per month
 - Books & Stationary grant and : TK 4,000/- per annum
 - Travel Grant : TK 3,000/- per annum
 - Return air fare
 - Free furnished accommodation
 - Medical Facilities
 - 15 days leave

The fellow will be a full time research worker and shall not accept any other appointment during the period.

Bhutan

- Adequate amount of monthly stipend;
- Accommodation
- Appropriate amount for books & stationary;
- Free medical facilities in Bhutan and;
- cost of internal travel

Pakistan

- Rs.60,000/- per annum;
