**Sub :** Rules regarding Eligibility and submission of  
Eligibility forms.

The Principals of the constituents and affiliated colleges are requested to forward to the University office the application for eligibility certificates together with the prescribed fees from the students joining their colleges during the academic year 1993-94.

Please note that the Eligibility rules strictly be followed while giving admission to the students and if any candidate is found ineligible, the Principal / Head concerned will be held personally responsible for the lapse and is also liable for action as per Ordinance No. 168 and the University office shall not be a party to any litigation arising out of this critical position.

Last dates of receiving eligibility forms by the University are given below. If the date falls on Sunday or holiday, the last date should be reckoned upto next working day immediately thereafter.

For the conditions of eligibility for new students, the procedure for submission of eligibility form to the university, please refer circular No. 9 of 1992 issued vide No. NMU/1992/Eligibility/40/3295 dated 11.04.92.

For any reason no form for eligibility will be accepted after the date as given in the column no. 4 above.

It shall be the responsibility of the Principals of colleges/ Heads of Departments/ Institutions that only eligible candidate is admitted to the respective Class/Course according to the eligibility conditions laid down in that behalf.

They should also ensure that eligibility is finalised by the University before the end of second term. While sending the application form for eligibility certificate in respect of the student migrating from the jurisdiction of another University / Board, the following certificates in original along with zerox copy of each shall be attached to each application. -

- 1) Migration Certificate
- 2) Attendance Certificate/Transference Certificate
- 3) Passing Certificate
- 4) Statement of Marks of the last qualifying examination
- 5) Degree certificate obtained at convocation (In case of admission to Post Graduation, M.Phil, and after graduation course)
- 6) Character certificate.

Kindly note that in absence of any of the certificates mentioned above, final eligibility certificate can not be issued to the concerned students. The examination form of the students, whose eligibility is not finalised, be sent separately to the University with prior approval of the Register with a remark, "The Eligibility is not finalised" under the signature of Principal/ Head and the concerned student. (As per Ordinance No. 60).

Note :

In a rare case if the candidate cannot furnish requisite certificates along with the forms, he should undertake to comply with them before the end of the first term failing which his/her result of the concerned examination will be kept in reserve. The form for eligibility must however be sent before the last date prescribed above.

1] While forwarding the applications, the Principals/ Directors are requested to arrange the application class wise under two categories as follows.

(a) Students joining First year [Art, Science and Commerce and other courses] after passing the Higher Secondary School Certificate examination [12th Std.] of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education must fill in the prescribed white form.

(b) Students joining the various courses on the strength of passing the qualifying equivalent examinations of other statutory University/Board must fill in the prescribed green form meant for students of other Universities / Boards.

2] SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION :

For Higher Secondary Certificate eligibility under category 1(a) above, the attested true copy of the statement of marks be attached to the application form and the original statement of marks of all applicants arranged in the same serial order of applications and be sent with list in the same cover.

Clarification regarding change in name if any be given with the application it self. The original migration certificate from all candidates (except candidate passing 12 th std. examination for Maharashtra State Board) will be attached to the application. The same will not be returned to the candidate. In case of student, seeking admission after passing the Diploma course from the Board of Technical Examination Maharashtra State, duplicate leaving certificate be attached to the application. [Refer circular No. 84/1992 issued vide No. NMU/6/9312 dt. 09.09.92.].

The fees collected by the Principals should be remitted to the Registrar, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon through common Demand Draft. Separate Demand Draft should be sent in respect of the fees collected from the students in categories at 1 (a) and (b) above.

The applications under category 1[a] and [b] should be accompanied with a list in triplicate arranged according to the categories above. The Principal should endorse a certificate as specified in Circular No. 24/93 issued by the University under No. NMU/93/6/40/2751, dt. 22.03.93 on one of the fair lists. Please ascertain that the applications are filled in completely and original certificates etc. along with true copies thereof are attached with the applications. If the true copies are not supplied with the application, the original certificates will be kept in the University office for permanent record.

The Principals/Heads may refer the cases in case of any difficulty in deciding the eligibility of any candidate, to the University along with all the necessary documents.

The Principals/Heads, are requested to co-operate in ensuring that no irregular admissions are granted as the University may not be in a position to rectify the irregular admissions under any circumstances, at a later date.

3) FEES :

The eligibility fee should be sent by common demand draft for all the student.

- a) Fee for certificate of eligibility for students migrating to this University from Universities/ Boards in the State of Maharashtra Rs. 30/- for those migrating from the Universities/ Boards outside the State of Maharashtra is Rs. 60/- and for Foreign national students including those passing the examination from statutory Board/ University in India is Rs. 200/-
- b) A Foreign national passing the qualifying Examination from the Statutory Board/University in India should be admitted directly subject to the production of passport, visa and entrance fee of US \$ 100 and medical certificate to the University office before the end of first term. The student must fill in the prescribed form meant for the foreign student for the eligibility certificate.

4) ADMISSION TO FOREIGN STUDENTS:

VISA:

- A) As per the directives of the Government of India, Ministry of Education, New Delhi, No self supporting foreign student be admitted or allowed to continue in the college without a student visa.

B) A foreign national passing Higher Secondary Examination [XII th Std.] of Maharashtra State should not be admitted directly to any course by the College /Institution without a student visa.

5) MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND ENTRANCE TEST :

The student coming from Commonwealth Countries are not required produce student visa. Admission letter will be issued only to the fresh foreign students excluding the foreign students migrating from Indian Universities. A foreign student will be issued a letter of eligibility/admission only on receiving certificate of blood test from National Institute of Virology Pune-1 and a certificate of medical fitness. Foreign students who are joining the University after passing the Examination from any statutory Universities in India will have to pay fee US Dollars 100 (One hundred U.S. Dollars) per student. A fresh foreign candidate is required to submit his eligibility form on or before 10th May of the year.

6) INFORMATION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS :

All degree or Diploma Examinations from Foreign Countries have not been given general recognition for admission to any of the course of this University.

After admissions of all the foreign students are over, Principals/ Directors/ Heads are requested to send to eligibility section, a countrywise list of fresh foreign students mentioning their in eligibility case No. and the course for the relevant academic year.



Foreign students should not be admitted to any of the management and technical courses or to any course from the faculties of engineering and medicine without prior approval of the Government of India, New Delhi.

No Nigerian student be admitted to any college without the approval of C.B.N.

The Principals of colleges should not give any admission to any Iraqi student to any course of study until they receive a recommendation of the Embassy of the Republic of Iraq, or the Ministry of Education and culture, Government of India, New Delhi.

7) **ADMISSION IN ANTICIPATION OF RESULTS:**

The Principals of the colleges are requested to verify the original statement of marks of the qualifying Examination within one month from the date of admission in the case of students who have been granted provisional eligibility under ordinance 59 in anticipation of their Examination results. The admission of the candidates who will not produce the document within stipulated time or who are failed at the qualifying Examination be cancelled and their names be reported to the University office immediately thereafter.

8) **ALL DEGREES DIPLOMAS RECOGNISED:**

The University has decided that all the Degrees and Diplomas awarded by the Statutory Universities in India be recognised for the purpose of admission to higher courses on reciprocal basis.

Mere eligibility, however, does not confer a right admission to the course and it is left to the Principal of college/Institute to decide whether a candidate is to be granted admission or otherwise.

9) A list of students who produce provisional eligibility certificate but did not join or after joining the course for a short period discontinued the course during I / II term should be forwarded to the University on 1st October, and 1st March of every year respectively. No transference certificate should be issued in their favour unless final eligibility certificate is issued by the University office.

**10) CHANGE IN NAME:**

Generally, the name as entered in the Original statement of Marks/ Passing certificate/ Degree certificate is treated as valid for declaring eligibility. In case, there is a discrepancy in the name written by the student in the application and shown in the statement of Marks/ Passing certificate/ Degree certificate, the student should produce documentary proof for a change in name e.g. Copy of Government Gazette, Marriage Invitation card, Marriage Registration certificate, Original affidavit made before a Judicial Magistrate etc. along with the application, for eligibility itself. No final eligibility certificate will be issued in the absence of such supporting documents in the name written in the application.

**11) MIGRATION CERTIFICATE:**

Application for Migration certificate received in the college office may be immediately forwarded to the University office duly completed, along with original transference certificate. Entry of the name of the student in the migration form and transference certificate be checked carefully in order to avoid unnecessary correspondence. Migration forms are available in the University office at a price of Rs.5/- each.

12) This University does not register any candidate as an External / Private student. The candidate registered by other Universities / Boards as an External/ Private student shall not be allowed to join college for next subsequent higher class/ semester. It is, therefore, necessary for a student to produce bonafide certificate of qualifying Examination from College/ Institution, last attended by him as a regular student, if he desires to take admission as a regular student.

However, the students who have passed XIIth std. examination of Maharashtra state Board, by filling Number 17th form, are eligible for admission to FY Arts and FY commerce course taking into consideration the eligibility rules prescribed in Para 31 (i) and (ii) respectively (See page no. 19).

13) A.T.K.T. STUDENTS FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

Unsuccessful students, at the Higher Secondary Examination [12 years course] and the Intermediate Examination of Statutory Boards should not be admitted in anticipation that they would pass at the Compartmental/Supplementary Examination. Students getting A.T.K.T. concession from any Statutory University in India may not be admitted to Higher Class.

14. A.T.K.T. AT PRE DEGREE:

The students who have obtained A.T.P.T./A.T.K.T./ Supplementary at the Pre/Degree Arts, Science and Commerce, examination in all Universities including Poona University are not eligible for admission to any course in this University.

15. CASES OF FAILURES FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

Students who have failed at the Intermediate Arts/Intermediate Science/Intermediate Commerce or B.A. Part-I/ B.Com. Part-I/B.Sc. Part-I examination of other Universities

should not be admitted to the same class unless it is confirmed that such students have passed the lower qualifying examination.

16. S.S.C. WITH G.C.D.:

Students passing the S.S.C. examination with English and Government Commercial Diploma Examination of the Government of Maharashtra are not held eligible for admission to the F.Y. course.

17. H.S.C. 11 YEAR COURSE AND L.S.C.:

i) Students passing the Higher Secondary Examination of any Board (the duration of which is 11 years) are not eligible for admission to the First Year of the Three years Degree Course. Such students are not eligible for admission to other course also where H.S.C.(XII) or equivalent examination is the minimum qualification.

ii) Students passing the School level Examination conducted by the following Boards should not be admitted to any course in this University.

1) The Central Board of Higher Education, Tilak Nagar, New Delhi - 110 018.

) The Central Board of Higher Education, 39/7 East Patel Nagar, New Delhi.

The Central Board of Higher Education, Vachaspati Bhavan, New Delhi.

iii) Students passing Higher Secondary (XI Std.) Examination from Rajasthan Board/M.P. Board, Bhopal are not eligible for admission to any course.

iv) Students who have passed the Degree Examination from Dnyaneshwar Vidyapeeth are not eligible for admission to Post-Graduate Course in any faculty.

18. CORPORAL TEST:

The students who have passed the S.S.C. whether X years or XI years with English and I.A.F. Educational Test for promotion to the rank of Corporal, are held eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.A. and First Year of New Five Year Law Course.

19. INTERMEDIATE EXAMINATION OF ANDHRA PRADESH:

The Candidates passing Intermediate examination from the Board of Intermediate Education Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and the Uttar Pradesh Board, Allahabad, should be admitted only for the first year of the Three Year Degree Course according to the bias of the subjects offered at the Intermediate examination.

20. INTERMEDIATE ARTS, COMMERCE AND SCIENCE ADMISSION

(M.P. BOARD, BHOPAL):

Students who have passed the Intermediate Commerce Examination or Intermediate Arts Examination from the Board of Secondary Education M.P., Bhopal with four subjects including General English may be admitted to the F.Y.B.Com./F.Y.B.A. Course respectively; according to the bias of the subjects offered at the intermediate examination.

Students who have passed the Intermediate Science examination with Compulsory English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Mathematics from the Board of Secondary Education, M.P. Board Bhopal are eligible for admission to F.Y.B.Sc. course provided the examination is passed as regular candidate and not as private or external student.

21. BIHAR STATE CANDIDATES:

Students passing Intermediate examination with English from the University in the State of Bihar are eligible for first year of three year Degree course according to the bias of subjects offered at that examination.

22. ART TEACHER DIPLOMA:

The candidate who has passed Art Teacher Diploma is not eligible for any course. (Refer circular No. 83 issued vide No. NMU 92/6/9311 dated 09.09.92)

23. NATIONAL OPEN SCHOOL SENIOR SECONDARY EXAMINATION:

The candidate who has passed the Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School, Delhi with five subjects is not eligible for any course in this University.

24. ADMISSION OF D.ED. STUDENTS:

Student passing D.Ed. (with English) (Adhyapan Padavika/Shikshan Shastra Padvika - Two Years course) examination conducted by the Shikshan Prashikshan Mandal, may be admitted to the F.Y.B.A. and First Year of New Five Year Law Course. They must fill in the prescribed form of Eligibility (for students of other Board/University). They should submit the migration certificate.

25. TRAINED TEACHERS CERTIFICATE COURSE:

Students passing the "Trained Teachers" certificate course of the Interstate Board of Anglo Indian Education, New Delhi be admitted to the F.Y.B.A. Course.

26. ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA HOLDER IN ENGINEERING AND PHARMACY:

i) Diploma in Engineering:- The Students passing the final Diploma in Engineering Examination conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, be held eligible for admission to the First year of B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com. course and New five Year Law Course.

Engineering Diploma Holders (i.e. those passing D.C.E., D.M.E., D.E.E. etc.) are eligible to be admitted to the Diploma in Business Management Course if they have two years of professional experience after their passing the Diploma examination. And one year experience for the students who have completed their diploma course after passing the XIIth std. examination. Any experience prior to or during the course of the Diploma shall not be reckoned for the purpose of counting one/two years of experience.

ii) PHARMACY DIPLOMA HOLDERS:

Students passing Diploma in Pharmacy examination of two year's duration course of the Board of Technical Examination Maharashtra State, Bombay, Final Diploma Examination in Pharmacy of Poona University are eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.A./B.Sc/B.Com. course.

Note :

If Diploma holder students are admitted, the Duplicate Leaving Certificate issued by the concerned college may be attached along with the eligibility form. (Refer circular No. 84/1992, issued wide No. NMU/92/6/9312, dt. 09.09.92 ).

27. ADMISSION TO FIRST LL.B., DIPLOMA IN LABOUR LAWS AND  
LABOUR WELFARE AND DIPLOMA IN TAXATION LAWS:

A student passing Bachelor's Degree Examination in any faculty or any Statutory University shall be held eligible for admission to First Year LL.B., Diploma in Labour Laws and Labour Welfare and Diploma in Taxation Laws course.

- ii) A candidate passing the Higher Secondary examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education (10+2) or equivalent Examination with English is eligible for admission to First year of Five year law course.

28. ADMISSION TO SECOND LL.B.:

A candidate who has joined the Second LL.B. course of this University after passing the First LL.B. Examination from any other statutory University will have to appear and pass in those subjects of the first LL.B. Course of this University in which he has not already passed in North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Further, if he so desires, he will be exempted in any of the subjects of the Second LL.B. Examination of this University provided he has already passed the Second LL.B. Examination in those subjects at the parent University. However in this case he will not be awarded a class at the Second LL.B. Examination.

29. ADMISSION TO THIRD LL.B.:

A student passing the Second year LL.B [LL.B. General] Examination from a statutory Indian University is allow to seek admission to the Third LL.B. Course in this University on condition that he shall appear for and passed in all the papers



prescribed for the Third LL.B. Examination of this University provided he has already passed in those subject at the parent University. However, in this case he will be required to appear and passed in the deficient papers according to syllabus of First LL.B. / Second LL.B. of this University. Further in such a case he will not be awarded a class at the Third LL.B. Examination.

Students passing First / Second LL.B. Examination [Privately or / Externally ] are not eligible for admission to the Second LL.B. / Third LL.B. course in the colleges affiliated to University.

30. ADMISSIONS TO M.B.A., D.B.M., M.P.M., D.O.M., D.C.M., M.M.S.  
AND M.S.W. COURSE:

The admission to the M.B.A., D.B.M., M.P.M., D.O.M., D.C.M., M.M.S. and M.S.W. Courses and such other courses should strictly be made in accordance with the conditions mentioned in the syllabi. The Certificate of experience, etc. wherever necessary, should be sent along with the eligibility form itself failing which the admission to the Course may be cancelled at any stage. Foreign students should not be admitted to these courses without prior approval of the Government of India, New Delhi.

- i) M.B.A. Course:- For admission to the M.B.A. Course, candidate must have passed the Degree or Post Graduate examination of a recognised University with Second class or minimum of 50% marks. [45 % in case of reserved categories]. The students who are admitted to the M.B.A. Course are requested to fill in the eligibility form, along with the prescribed fee and same the send through the respective College / Institution for deciding their final eligibility to the said course.

The candidate will have to appear for entrance examination and qualifying tests for M.B.A. Course which will be held by this University. After Selection, he may be admitted to M.B.A. Course.

ii) D.B.M. Course:- Every candidate seeking admission to the Two year Diploma course in Business Management shall have passed the Bachelor's Examination of any statutory Indian University or Recognised Foreign University.

iii) M.C.M. Course:- For admission to the M.C.M. Course, candidate must have passed the Degree examination with minimum 45% marks.

iv) M.P.M. Course:- For admission to the M.P.M. Course, candidate must have passed the Degree examination with minimum 45% marks.

31. ADMISSION OF H.S.C. (XIIITH STD.) STUDENTS:

Students passing with English, 10+2 examination conducted by the Recognised Statutory Boards / Universities in India will be considered for admission to the Higher Course in this University provided they fulfill requirements of eligibility and admission to the course.

The following shall be the rules of eligibility for admission to the First Year of three Year Degree Course after passing H.S.C. (XII Std. Examination) of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education with particular subjects given below among his passing subjects.

A certificate showing the caste validity of candidate who has obtained admission in B.C. category, is required to be produced in case of admission to Medical, Engineering, Pharmacy & Law Courses.

### S U B J E C T S

i) Arts :

A candidate passing the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education of Arts Commerce & Science Streams with English as passing subject shall be admitted to the F.Y.B.A. Course.

ii) Commerce :

A candidate passing the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination in Science and Commerce streams with English as passing subject shall only be admitted to the F.Y.B.Com. Course.

iii) Science :

A candidate passing H.S.C. Examination (10+2) with English and any three Science subjects out of a) Physics b) Chemistry c) Biology d) Mathematics e) Geography f) Geology etc. held eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.Sc. Course/F.Y.B.Sc. (Electronics) course.

iv) F.Y.B.Sc. ( Computer Course ) :

A candidate passing Higher Secondary Certificate Examination [10 + 2] or any equivalent Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education with English, Mathematics and Physics should be held eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.Sc. computer course. If he passes the entrance test held therefore.

(Note :- The Colleges are requested to prepare separate lists of candidates admitted to these courses for each course and their eligibility applications also be attached to the concerned lists).

v) Engineering

A candidate passing the H.S.C. (10+2) or its equivalent examination in a single sitting with English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as passing subjects and with not less than 60% marks ( 45% marks or the conditions prescribed by the Maharashtra State Government in respect of Backward Class candidates from Maharashtra State, if they produce caste validity certificate from appropriate authorities at the time of seeking admission) in subjects of Physics; Chemistry and Mathematics should be held eligible to First year Engineering course.

vi) Medicine and Dentistry :

A candidate passing the H.S.C. or its equivalent examination at one and the same sitting with English, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as passing subject and with not less than 50% marks in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together is eligible for admission to the First Year M.B.B.S./ B.D.S. Course.

Candidates belonging to Backward class communities from Maharashtra State (i.e. Scheduled castes, Schedules Tribes, Denotified Tribes and Nomedic Tribes and other Backward class ) must have obtained not less than 40 % of the total marks in English and Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together at one

and same attempt in the H.S.C. Examination is eligible for M.B.B.S. Such candidate have to submit Caste Validity Certificate issued by the appropriate authority at the time of seeking admission.

vii) AYURVEDIC COURSE:-

A candidate passing Intermediate / Higher Secondary Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education at one of the same seating i.e. in First attempt with not less than 50% marks in ( 40 % marks in case of Backward class students from Maharashtra State only if they produce caste validity certificate issued by the appropriate authority at the time of seeking admission ) Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together shall be eligible to the First year of B.A.M.S. Course.

**IMPORTANT NOTE :-** The condition of minimum age limit for admission to Ist M.B.B.S. and Ist B.A.M.S. course be confirmed before granting admission .

viii) PHARMACY :

The minimum qualification for admission to Degree course in Pharmacy will be passing the 10 + 2 [ XIIth STD.] Science, Stream Examination in single attempt with a minimum aggregate of 50 % marks [ 45 % marks in case of SC,ST,DTNT students ] in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. The candidate should also have passed in the subject of Mathematics at 10 + 2 [ XIIth STD. Examination ].

[ NOTE : In case of Boards/ States where Mathematics is not offered along with Physics, Chemistry & Biology compulsorily, the Candidates getting admission in B. Pharmacy course on the basis of Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall offer additional paper in Mathematics as per the syllabus given in appendix IV.

ii) All the admissions will be made as per AICTE rules including reservation. [Refer circular No. 75 of 1992 issued vide No. NMU/92/6/40/8480 dated 20.08.92.]

ix) B.H.M.S. (HOMOEOPATHY) :

A candidate passing the H.S.C. (10+2) with at least four subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology as passing subjects should be held eligible for admission to the First Year B.H.M.S. Course.

x) ARCHITECTURE :

The candidate should have passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (XII Std) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics with not less than 50% marks in aggregate and also in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together at one and the same seating.

### 32. MIGRATION OF STUDENTS FOR ENGINEERING COURSE:-

The Migration of the students from one University to another University in Maharashtra is permitted upto the Third

Year of the B.E. Course.

33. ADMISSION TO SECOND YEAR ENGINEERING COURSE:

The candidate should have passed in First class the Diploma in Engineering of the Board of Technical Examination Maharashtra State Bombay or Victoria Jubilee Technical Institute Bombay or any Polytechnic which has been granted academic autonomy by the Government of Maharashtra or SNDT University Bombay or any Diploma course in Engineering recognised as equivalent thereto within the minimum prescribed period. The candidate who is domicile in the Maharashtra State and has passed in First class the Diploma course in Engineering. [Recognised or equivalent to Diploma course of the Board of Technical Examinations, Maharashtra State Bombay] from other State will also be eligible for direct admission to Second year Degree course in Engineering in this State. If a University has prescribed any additional conditions for eligibility the same shall be applicable for admission to a college affiliated to that University.

The condition of passing of Diploma course in Engineering in first class within the minimum prescribed period shall be applicable only to the students admitted to the Diploma course in engineering during or after the academic year 1989-90.

- ii) University authorities have decided that the Diploma of various courses of various branches of engineering and technology awarded by the recognised university and State boards in India be treated as equivalent with the corresponding Diploma course awarded by the Board of Technical Examination, Maharashtra State Bombay academically provided medium of instruction of such

Diploma course in English and duration of course is not less than that of the Diploma course of Board of Technical Examination Maharashtra State, Bombay. Principals of the colleges should ensure that the admission of such Diploma Holder students shall not exceed 10% of the original intake capacity.

34. The students who are graduates from the faculties other than Arts, Mental, Moral and Social Sciences are allowed to keep terms for S.Y.B.A. course without appearing or keeping terms for F.Y.B.A. course. The students who appear under this rule are eligible for award of class (Refer circular No. 74/92, issued under no. Eligibility/92/6/8296, dt. 12/8/92).

35. ADMISSION TO B.LIB COURSE:

A student passing Bachelor Degree Examination or Post Graduate Degree Examination with minimum 50 % marks of this university or any other Indian Statutory University recognised by the North Maharashtra University Jalgaon shall be eligible for Bachelor of Library and Information Science course. Remaining rules of admission be followed strictly according to those mentioned in the syllabi.

36. Any Degree holder of a Statutory Indian University is allowed to keep terms to the Master's Degree course in the Faculties of Arts, Mental, Moral and Social Sciences, Science., Commerce and Fine Arts (painting). This concession is only for the Faculties mentioned above and not applicable to the Professional faculties.




37. The Principals /Directors/Heads are requested to send the eligibility forms along with all certificates required as per rules so as to reach the University on or before the dates mentioned above. They are further requested to send the fees through demand draft only. It may be noted that cheques will not be accepted under any circumstances. Application forms not accompanied by Demand Draft will not be accepted and late fee will be charged to the concerned College. The application forms with fee for certificates of eligibility should be submitted to the college by the students at the time of admission and college should send all the applications with separate demand draft of fees collected from students as per category 1(a), 1(b) mentioned earlier and so as to reach the University on or before the dates mentioned above.

38. The Principals of affiliated Colleges, Directors of recognised institutes/Heads of University Departments are earnestly requested to ensure that admissions are given strictly in accordance with rules and regulations. If the Colleges/Institutes have any difficulty while deciding the eligibility of any candidate for admission to any course, they should refer the case to the University along with all certificates.

39. The Principals are requested to note that no irregular admission will be rectified under any circumstances.
