

The format of question paper of Special Paper-IV will be the same as that of Special Paper-III (1993-94 examination) with appropriate alterations in the scheme of marking bringing it from 100 marks to 80 marks, as this paper will have theory paper of 60 Marks and will have a separate practical examination of 20 Marks.
